- Industrial policy;
- Formation of mechanisms for sustainable economic development of industrial sectors, complexes, enterprises;
- Public-private partnership in industry;
- Fuel and energy balance of the country and administrative territorial entities;
- Problems of increasing energy efficiency and use alternative energy sources;
- Structural changes in industry and their management;
- Tools for intra-company and strategic planning at industrial enterprises, industries, and complexes.
